# Clinton County Succeeds Program Agreement

The purpose of the Clinton County Succeeds Program (CCSP) is to assist county students with tuition costs associated with attending Wilmington College. Candidates for the Clinton County Succeeds Program are subject to the provisions of eligibility, obligations and the terms and conditions set forth in this agreement.

## Program Provisions of Eligibility

- 1) A candidate must be a high school graduate from the Class of 2018 or after.
- 2) A candidate must meet one of the following circumstances:
  - a) A Clinton County resident for the past two years and graduates from a county public, private or home school.
  - b) A Clinton County resident for the past two years and graduates from a non-county public and private school.
  - c) A non-Clinton County resident and graduates from a county public or private school.
- 3) In addition to the above criteria, transfer candidates must be an AA, AS or AAS graduate from Southern State Community College (SSCC) transferring directly to Wilmington College.

## Program Obligations

- 4) I must submit a valid Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year.
- 5) I must be enrolled as a full-time (12-18 credit hours), degree-seeking student at Wilmington College.
- 6) I must continue to meet Financial Aid Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards each semester.  
*The Satisfactory Academic Progress policy is available in the Wilmington College Catalog.*
- 7) I must remain in good social standing with the Vice President of Student Affairs and Dean of Students.
- 8) I must continue my education at and graduate from Wilmington College.

## Program Awareness

- 9) I acknowledge that my eligibility for CCSP may not exceed eight semesters (four semesters for SSCC transfer students) and expires upon graduation. Unused funds are forfeited and carry no cash value.
- 10) I understand that my eligibility is not impacted by College Credit Plus transfer credits that may accelerate my student classification. (Sophomore = 30-59.99 credit hours | Junior = 60-89.99 credit hours | Senior = 90+ credit hours)
- 11) I accept that the CCSP is need-based (determined by the FAFSA), and that I may not qualify every year or receive the full allotted amount each year.
- 12) I understand that CCSP only applies to fall and spring semester tuition costs and may not be applied toward fees, room and board, books or misc. educational expenses.
- 13) I understand that the College has the right to reduce or reverse CCSP (and other institutional aid) funds, when combined, exceed tuition and/or the total cost of attendance. Ex: institutional, external, federal or state aid.

## Program Terms & Conditions

- 14) I understand to withdraw or being withdrawn from the College repeals my CCSP eligibility and revokes the funds received to date (including previous academic years).
- 15) I acknowledge that failure to meet the eligibility and obligations set forth in this agreement will result in the CCSP being nullified in its entirety and an adjustment will be invoiced through my student account.

## Program Certification

- By signing this form, I certify that I have thoroughly reviewed, understand and accept the specifications outlined in this Clinton County Succeeds Program Agreement.*
- I have read the above agreement and have decided to opt out of the Clinton County Succeeds Program. In doing so, I understand the funds will be rescinded, and I am responsible for the student account balance incurred as a result.*
