COMMUTERS ARE NOT REQUIRED TO HAVE A MEAL PLAN BUT MAY TAKE ANY PLAN WE OFFER. CALL EXT. 312 FOR DETAILS

Wilmington College offers four meal plans. Each has a set number of meals and dining dollars that may be used at the Underground, (the campus snack bar). Meals are served in our dining hall, the T.O.P. (Top of the Pyle Center). Meal plans are mandatory for all residential students.

1. CARTE BLANCHE MEAL PLAN

- Unlimited meals in the T.O.P.
- \$25.00 to the Underground

**Cost: \$2,505 per semester
\$5,010 per year**

REQUIRED FOR ALL 1ST YEAR RESIDENTIAL STUDENTS FOR FALL 2014 TERM.

2. BLOCK MEAL PLAN

- 160 meals per semester
- \$85.00 to the Underground

**Cost: \$2,505 per semester
\$5,010 per year**

STUDENTS WHO LIVE IN **STANDARD** RESIDENCE HALLS (AUSTIN, PICKETT, DENVER, FRIENDS AND MARBLE HALLS) MUST CHOOSE BETWEEN THE **CARTE BLANCHE** AND THE **160 BLOCK MEAL PLANS**. COST IS THE SAME.

3. PREFERRED MEAL PLAN

- 35 meals per semester
- \$50.00 to the Underground

**Cost: \$325 per semester
\$650 per year**

STUDENTS WHO LIVE IN **PREFERRED** HOUSING (CAMPUS VILLAGE, COLLEGE COMMONS, COLLEGE-OWNED GREEK HOUSES, ECO HOUSES AND FIFE HALL) ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE AT MINIMUM THE **PREFERRED MEAL PLAN**.

4. PREFERRED PLUS MEAL PLAN

- 50 meals per semester
- \$100.00 to the Underground

**Cost: \$500 per semester
\$995 per year**

STUDENTS IN **PREFERRED** HOUSING MAY CHOOSE ANY OF THE FOUR MEAL PLANS OFFERED AT THE COST INDICATED.

- Unused meals **DO NOT** roll over from fall to spring term. Unused dining dollars WILL roll forward. Any unused meals and dining dollars at the end of spring term will be forfeited.
- Students may pay-as-you-go for an individual meal via cash or credit card, but at a much higher rate than the prepaid meal plans.
