

The U.S. Department of Education has flagged your Parents Earnings from Work on your 2019–2020 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). To validate your parental earnings, you must review your parents 2017 Federal Income Tax Return.

### Step 1:

Determine which type of Tax Return (Form 1040, Form 1040A, or Form 1040EZ) your parents submitted to the IRS. This information can be found in the top, left corner of the tax document. Check the appropriate tax document box below.

### Step 2:

Using the line number in the chart below, look at your parents Tax Return and determine if a dollar amount (other than \$0) was reported in the line number referenced. If so, you will need to attach a copy of the tax document noted. In most cases, Line 7 of the W–2 Statement should be the total of Box 1 from all W–2 Statements.

**NOTE:** *If your parents had more than one income source, they may have multiple W–2 Statements or Schedules that you will need to submit.*

### Step 3:

Submit all tax document copies to the Student One Stop Center.
